As we close another successful school year, there are many "Points of Pride" highlighted in this *Torchbearer* issue. I would like to underline our school district's outstanding MEAP scores. Our students were tested in various subjects including Reading, Writing, English and Language Arts, Science, Social Studies and Mathematics. Columbia School District scored above the state average in every level and every subject except seventh grade mathematics, which was even with the state average. The outstanding results are a direct reflection on our ongoing curriculum review cycle, continuous Professional Development, Collins Writing Across the Curriculum Program, Teacher Learning Teams and the integration of our technology support. MEAP assessment measures what a student should know and be able to do in each of the content areas and grades assessed. Currently the state awards Merit Scholarships to 12th grade students meeting state requirements.

On behalf of the Columbia Board of Education and our Administrators, I congratulate our teachers, support staff and especially our students on the tremendous MEAP scores and know they will continue to pursue excellence in education. Safe and Drug Free Report

One of the most exciting ends to our school year is watching the 6th grade girls cross the finish line at the Advanced Packaging 5K run. Girl Quest is one of the many beneficial programs that Safe and Drug Free Funds allow to take place throughout the school year. Girl Quest is a program in which 6th grade girls learn about nutrition, exercise, self-esteem, problem solving, and communication skills while training to run a 5K. The girls receive a free pair of Asics tennis shoes and a t-shirt. This interactive program has a huge impact on the social and physical growth of our young girls. We hope to include a Boy Quest next year. In addition to Girl Quest, Safe and Drug Free funds help to continue the FACT backpack program. The FACT program takes place in both elementary schools. The goal is to bring families together for an evening of fun and to develop assets within the home. All students in our district benefit from the Michigan Health Model curriculum. This curriculum includes, Violence Prevention, Substance Abuse and Tobacco Prevention, Character Development and Service Learning. The materials and staff training are funded through Safe and Drug Free funds. The most beneficial impact of Michigan Health Model in our district is that our students begin to understand and practice making responsible health choices for their future. Finally, the 10th grade students take an active role in the Reducing Underage Drinking and Driving Program with Safe and Drug Free Funds. A trained instructor and police officer discuss the consequences of poor decision making with the students. This program engages students in activities to become aware of the dangers of alcohol and substance abuse. As a staff, we continue to promote the health and safety of all of our students. Safe and Drug Free funds assists us in this effort.

Everyone has a character of some sort, but not everyone "has character." Having character is shorthand for having good character, and that means being a person who is admirable because of his self-assured, ethical behavior. Character is ethics in action. Throughout this issue and in many past issues the *Torchbearer* has highlighted good character traits demonstrated by many of our students. Mr. Zach Kanaan, Assistant Principal at the high school, has been charged with and enthusiastically embraces the responsibility to implement a program, hopefully throughout the district, to guide our young people in ways to continue developing good character. A final presentation will be made before the Columbia Board of Education explaining how we hope to implement the program and requesting their endorsement.

Principals of the program...**Be a T.E.A.M. Player.**

Teach CHILDREN THAT THEIR CHARACTER COUNTS

Explain that their success and happiness depend on who they are inside, not on what they have or how they look. Teach them the difference between right and wrong and guide their thoughts and actions by the **Six Pillars of Character**: *Trustworthiness, Respect, Responsibility, Fairness, Caring and Citizen ship.*

Enforce CHARACTER

Reward good behavior and discourage bad behavior by imposing fair, consistent consequences. Demonstrate courage and firmness of will by enforcing these core values even when it is difficult and costly to do so.

Advocate CHARACTER

Continually encourage children to live up to the **Six Pillars of Character**. Don't be neutral about the importance of character, and don't be casual about improper conduct. Be clear and uncompromising that you expect children to be trustworthy, respectful, responsible, fair, caring and good citizens.

Model GOOD BEHAVIOR

Everything you say and do sends a message about your values. Be sure these messages reinforce your lessons about doing the right thing, even when it is difficult. When you slip, be accountable; apologize sincerely and do better.

The **Six Pillars of Character** can be used throughout this character counts series. Striving for consistency throughout the district, Mr. Kanaan hopes to involve our staff, students, parents and interested community members to dialog and share their ideas of implementation and our staff as to how to integrate into the curriculum. As this tool continues to be developed, look for additional information provided through your child's school and in a future *Torchbearer* issue. We all know, parenting is the most important job of your life and helping develop a strong character is essential in preparing your children for life's adventure, on the premise that character is not inborn but rather developed through education, experience and choice.
